We have a wonderful teaching team and have been lucky to welcome another experienced teacher Rebecca to support the children in their everyday learning. The students are becoming more aware of the expectations of school and are becoming more independent at completing work tasks and following independent work schedules. During structured sessions, Michelle our Occupational Therapist has been working with the classroom teachers to develop programs, targeting fine motor skills, such as pegboards, threading, correct cutting skills, pre writing activities, and colouring within clear borders. We have also been focussing on gross motor development, such as body coordination and bike riding skills. Students have become more confident with transitioning to different environments within the school, such as going to the school gyms and different playgrounds. During structured play sessions, students are developing and working on a range of communication skills, such as responding to verbal instructions and requesting items. Our Speech Pathologist, April has also been working with the classroom teachers to implement individual strategies to extend the students' communication skills with their peers and adults. All the students are having fun and enjoy interacting with their peers. It has been wonderful to see the improvement in their learning so far! We are looking forward to more exciting times for the rest of the year.
