## **Playgrounds**



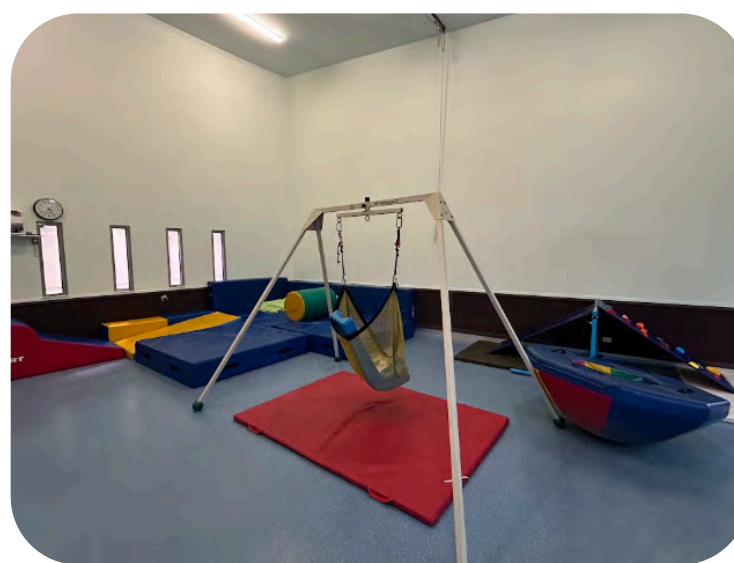
Students have access to swings, trampolines, climbing, scooters and bikes

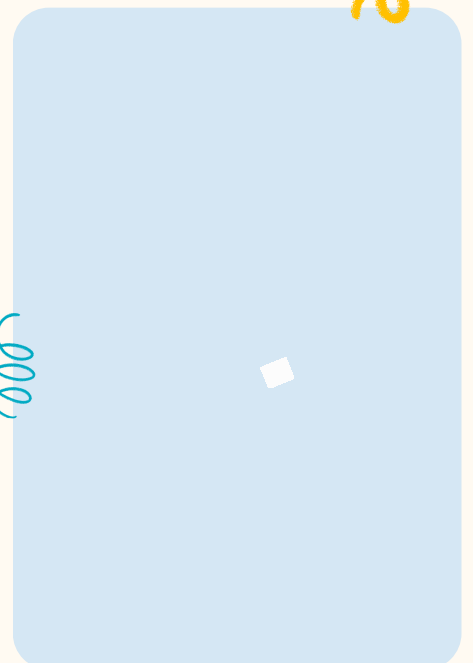
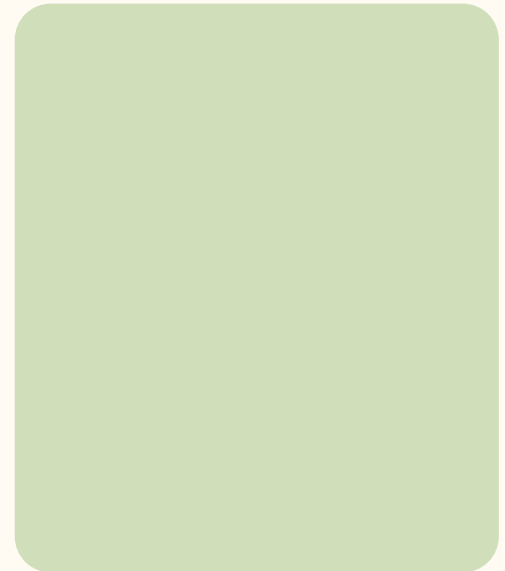


### ILP/Excursions

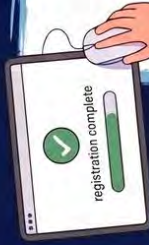
